All Tilbury Douglas Regional Building divisions are on the Department for Education Framework 2021, Medium value band works.

#### How the framework works for customers

Education projects majority funded by the Department for Education are generally procured through the CF21 framework.

Contractors tend to bid in mini-competitions to win projects, however direct awards are possible in special circumstances.

Tilbury Douglas in the Midlands have delivered multiple mainstream and special schools on the framework and in previous iterations.

Tilbury Douglas have been long standing highest scoring contractor on the framework according to KPI's. We are closely monitored and measured on all aspects of delivery.

Projects tend to be awarded to contractors and contractor design teams at a pre-planning.

Through this route, contractors tend to select their own design teams, however in some circumstances where planning has already been achieved, the design team can be novated.

CCS is a national government run framework. The approach suites knowledgeable clients with procurement teams that can use the framework as a platform to lead their own procurement process. The Framework is based on quality, so although there are a lot of competitors within each lot, they tend to be on the larger side, ie. Tier 1 contractors.

This framework is available to all public sector organisations including government departments and devolved administrations.


